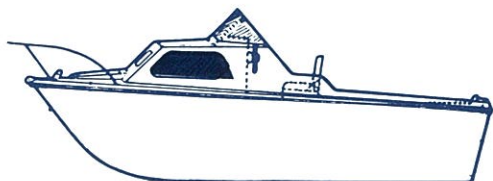

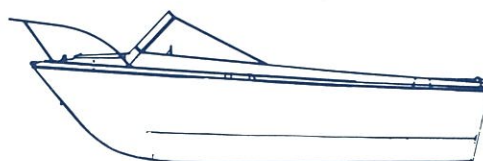

They simply won't stop talking. Boasting about their boat. So what is it that makes normally modest men become such boasters? Ask one about his new Steber craft and you'll soon find out.

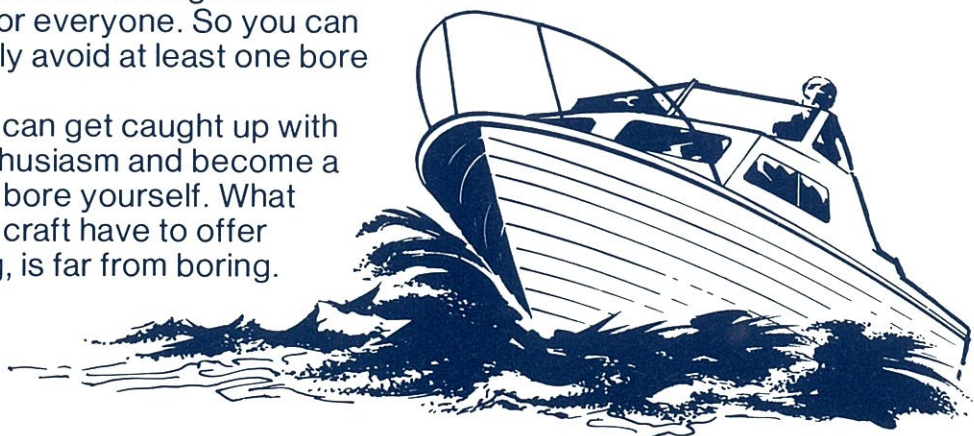
